



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BOUNCY CASTLE AND AMUSEMENT HIRE

It is the responsibility of the hirer to ensure that all possible steps are taken to avoid injury to users or damage to the inflatable. Please ensure that the following safety instructions are followed:

- 1) If the inflatable or amusement has an age limit (please check at time of hiring). You must ensure no one over this age uses the equipment. (If it is found that adults have used any equipment with specification for use by children, you may be liable to an additional payment of £70.00 to cover the cost of a safety test).
- 2) No food or drinks to be consumed whilst using the equipment (to avoid choking and mess).
- 3) All shoes, badges, jewellery, (i.e. large earrings, necklaces, etc.) must be removed. It is recommended that spectacles also be removed.
- 4) Party-poppers, coloured streamers "silly string" etc must not be used on or near the equipment, as they can make a terrible mess and permanently stain the unit.
- 5) No smoking near the equipment.
- 6) Climbing, hanging, or sitting on the walls is **DANGEROUS** and must not be allowed.
- 7) A responsible adult must supervise the equipment at all times.
- 8) Ensure that the equipment is not overcrowded, and limit the numbers depending on age and size of children using it. If the children are colliding into each other then it is too crowded.
- 9) Try to avoid large children and small children from using the equipment at the same time. Some children require strict supervision.
- 10) If you are hiring an inflatable please switch the blower off at the mains when not in use, this will save you wasting electricity.
- 11) When hiring inflatables Do not allow anyone to bounce on the step/front apron. The step is there to help users get on and off.
- 12) Ensure that no-one with a history of back or neck problems are allowed on an inflatable.
- 13) Do not allow users to be on an inflatable unit during inflation or deflation.
- 14) In the event of heavy rain, it is strongly recommended that all inflatables be switched off. Any wetness, including bubbling can be dried with a towel. A small picnic table placed over the blower, will help prevent rain-water being sucked into the blower, and then into the inflatable.
- 15) With inflatables: The blower at the back has a safety-reset button. In the event that it overheats, or loses power, switch the blower off at the mains, and then switch it back on again 1 or 2 minutes later, and it should restart. If it does not, or there is a power cut, inform us **IMMEDIATELY**.
- 16) With inflatables: ensure that the vent on the side of the blower is kept clear at all times.
- 17) If you are unsure about anything, please contact **SASAQUADS**.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: provided that the equipment is used in accordance with the above guidelines and conditions of hire, those using the inflatable should do so safely. However, accidents can and do happen. **SASAQUADS** can accept no liability for injuries sustained or any other loss howsoever caused, in the absence of the negligence of **SASAQUADS** or its employees. As the equipment will be in the hirer's possession and control whilst in use (rather than **SASAQUADS**) any liability for injuries or other losses caused other than in the circumstances described above is the responsibility of the person / organisation hiring the equipment. Accordingly, it is strongly recommended that the hirer have adequate public liability insurance covering his or her liability arising from the use of the equipment. The person / organisation hiring the equipment will be responsible / liable for any damage occurring from misuse or reckless use.
